FORT WORTH'S FIRST TRANSGENDER DAY OF VISIBILITY OBSERVANCE TO BE HELD MARCH 31

FORT WORTH — The first annual Fort Worth observation of International Transgender Day of Visibility is scheduled for 5 p.m. March 31 at Celebration Community Church, 908 Pennsylvania Ave.

The event will include a moderated panel consisting of representatives of the FTM, MTF, non-binary/gender-fluid and SOFFAs (significant others, family, friends and allies) of the trans community. Finnigan Jones, executive director of Trans-Cendence International Inc., will open and close the presentation.

“Ignorance can only be dissolved through our willingness to educate,” said organizer Cason Esquivel. “With this panel, we strive to educate the community on the ‘T’ in the LGBTQ+ and all who identify under the ‘T’ umbrella.”

Following the panel discussion, refreshments will be served in the Celebration Community Church Fellowship Hall. There will be an opportunity to meet the panelists and to visit booths set up by organizations offering LGBTQ+ resources and information.
